A digital device is one that allows students to browse, create and edit documents efficiently. Students do not require a powerful (expensive) machine, nor do they need a large hard drive as they can easily save and share their work in the cloud. The school uses the Google suite of tools to work with and although not necessary to have your own device, for many students it is beneficial.

Listed below are the suggested minimum specifications for our BYOD programme:

Digital Device:

The school is currently using HP Chromebooks with specifications similar to those below:

- Intel Celeron N4020 with Intel UHD Graphics 600 (1.1 GHz base frequency, up to 2.8GHz burst frequency, 4MB Cache, 2 cores)
- 4 GB LPDDR4-2400 SD RAM
- 32GB eMMC Storage
- 11.6" HD SVA anti-glare WLED-backlit display
- Google Chrome OS
- Intel Dual Band Wireless-AC 9560 802.11a/b/g/n/ac (2x2) Wi-Fi and Bluetooth 5 Combo

Additional equipment likely to be required:

- Headphones
- Mouse
